Surrender, 13 March 1708

by John Woolard, by hands of William Marsh, William Linton jnr to Charles Offord of GB
 two customary tenants

marks of John Woolard; signs of William Marsh and William Linton
 outside endorsed Samuel Turner and mark of Joseph Parmenter

Court Leet, 27 July 1722

present those grazing cattle on the common without right Fine 12d a head
 no further ploughing up of land. Sow with hay
 present, Mr Fairse Cloth Clarke not keeping gate against hwy meadow Fine 5s
 present those putting cattle on common before corn taken out of it Fine 5s per offence
 continue all ancient bye laws
 nominate for constables : William Woollard, William Wheller
