Coppied from the DARBY Transcription made in 1823-46.

Darby copied the monumental inscriptions of this county between 1825- 1834 then revisited some sites around 1840. Copied ALL the heraldry & inscriptions in the churches. In the church yards only those on alter tombs or Esq. Gent. Clergy.

Every grave stone was numbered.

Bradley Magna. 1831.

7236. (On ground broken) ... Modern... this life 18 february...was baptised...; his wife, daughter of Walter Dersly, Poslingford, Gent. died 17 October 1709. Baptised 17 July 1632.

7237 (On ground) Robert Billingsley late rector of this parish. 25 March 1657.
