LANDS OF ROBERT OF TOSNY

RISBRIDGE Hundred

1 Ulf, a thane, held BRADLEY as a manor before 1066; now [Robert] holds (it) in lordship; 7 carucates of land.

Always 14 villagers; 12 smallholders; 6 slaves;

3 ploughs in lordship; 7 men's ploughs. Meadow, 13 acres; woodland, 500 pigs. Always 1 cob. Then 12 cattle, now 18; then 60 pigs, now 53; then 20 sheep, now 63;

7 goats; 1 beehive.

A church with 15 acres of free land.

Value then £6; now [£]18.

It has 1 league in length and 7 furlongs in width; 6d in tax.

BISHOP'S Hundred

2 Ulf held SYLEHAM, with the jurisdiction, before 1066; as a manor,

2½ carucates of land.

Then 8 villagers, now 3; then 12 smallholders, now 13; now 1 slave.

Always 3 ploughs in lordship. Then and later 12 men's ploughs,

now 4.

Woodland, 150 pigs; meadow, 8 acres; always 1 mill. Then 2 cobs, now 1; then 8 cattle, now 2; then 80 pigs, now 44. Now 7 sheep, 3 goats, 1 beehive.

Value then 100s; now the same.

In the same (Syleham) 5 free men under the patronage of [his] predecessor; 30 acres. Then 1 plough, now ½.

Meadow, 1 acre.

Value 5s.

A church with 16 acres; value 2s.

(It has) 1 league in length and 8 furlongs in width; 7½d in tax. The jurisdiction (is) in the Bishop's manor of Hoxne.
